**Scouts:** Compete against other Troops and Patrols in the District for 1st, 2nd, or 3rd place trophy as well as having your Troop/Patrol permanently inscribed on the "Traveling Trophy". Several different scenarios will be presented. How would you react in an emergency?

1st Aid problems are based on the Boy Scout handbook and the BSA First Aid Merit Badge book, most current edition.

A Troop may send any number of Patrols to the event. Minimum Patrol size is 4 participants. Maximum Patrol size is 8 participants.

Note: Each Patrol must provide an Adult Leader to act as a judge for the competition. A background in health care services (EMT, Nurse, Physician, etc.) will allow a Judge to provide insight of real-world experiences, but is NOT NECESSARY. Judges will be supplied with Score Sheets for each problem.

**Leaders:** While the scouts are competing for the First Aid Trophy, adult BSA training sessions will be offered. These include Youth Protection, Weather, and Risk Zone. If you have any new or seasoned leaders that need any of these trainings this would be a great opportunity to complete them.

**SUGGESTED BRING LIST** (but not required):

3 – Large Blankets (Splint, stretcher, floor mat)

2 – Sturdy Poles, 6-7 feet long for an improvised stretcher

The above items are to make a stretcher – you can substitute materials

6 splints of various sizes to splint forearm, knees, and lower legs

10 – Triangular bandages (at least 36” long) (can be cloth cut up)

6 – 3 x 3/ 4x4 inch compresses (sterility not necessary)

4 – 3”- 4” Kling/Gauze roller bandage (sterility not necessary)

Adhesive Tape, 1 inch

Soap

Antiseptic

Scissors

Latex Gloves

Plastic Goggles

Pencil and Paper

8x10 tarp

***Each scout should have a personal first aid kit***

***\$6 per participant goes towards covering cost of patches, awards, etc.***

Hot dogs, snacks and drinks will be available from the Church concession stand for a modest fee during a break in the competition.
